

## Five species of fleas (Siphonaptera) new to the Estonian fauna

*Amphipsylla rossica* Wagner was found in five Estonian localities: three on Saaremaa Island, western Estonia (Sakla 19–20.06.1987 2♂ 1♀, Korkvere 19–20.06.1987 3♂ 5♀, leg. U. Timm, V. Vassilenko, A. Pototski; Metsküla 20.05.1987 1♂, leg. V. Vassilenko, A. Pototski), and two in eastern Estonia (Sikakurmu, Tartu region 24–25.04.1987 11♂ 8♀, leg. E. Saar, L. Saag, M. Tsernósova, A. Pototski; Lüganuse, Kohtla-Järve region 23.07.1987 1♂ 2♀, leg. T. Maran, U. Timm, A. Pototski). The specimens were collected from *Microtus arvalis*, *M. agrestis*, *Clethrionomys glareolus* and *Mustela nivalis*.

*Ctenophthalmus assimilis* Taschenberg (2♂ 1♀) were collected 26.06.1987 from *Microtus*

*arvalis* in southwest Estonia on the small Manilaid Island, leg. U. Timm.

*Ctenophthalmus bisoctodentatus* Kolenati (1♂ 2♀) were collected 6.10.1987 from *Apodemus agrarius* in central Estonia (Velise, Rapla region, leg. P. Ernits, A. Lepik, M. Masing, U. Timm, A. Pototski).

*Ceratophyllus farreni* Rothschild (1♀) and *C. hirundinis* Curtis (6♀) were collected 25.04.1988 from the nests of *Delichon urbica* in central Estonia (Määo, Paide region).

Altogether 36 species of fleas are now known from Estonia.
