A new replacement name in Curculionidae (Coleoptera)

Bagous cylindrus (Paykull, 1800, nec Fabricius, 1781) (angustus Silfverberg, 1977, nec Tanner, 1954) is renamed Bagous scanicus nom. nov.

Several years ago I noticed that the name *Bagous cylindrus* (Paykull, 1800), originally introduced as *Curculio cylindrus*, was preoccupied by *Curculio cylindrus* Fabricius, 1781, and renamed the species *Bagous angustus* (Silfverberg 1977). Unfortunately this name had already been used for an American species (Tanner 1954), and the species is thus still without a valid name. Therefore I rename this species *Bagous scanicus* nom. nov., based on the original type locality.
