The 4th International Conference on BioMedical Engineering and Informatics (BMEI 2011) and 4th International Congress on Image and Signal Processing (CISP 2011 will be jointly held from 15-17 October 2011, in Shanghai, China. The deadline for the 2nd (final) round of submissions is 4 August 2011 (papers already submitted in the 1st round should not be re-submitted and will receive review notifications on 25 June; however, authors who have submitted in the 1st round are welcome to submit new papers in the 2nd round).

Shanghai is the largest city in China, with famous historical and cultural heritage. BMEI'11-CISP'11 is technically co-sponsored by the IEEE Engineering in Medicine and Biology Society.
