All submitted manuscripts are evaluated by the editor. Manuscripts that are considered suitable for publication in the Journal are sent to two referees for assessment. The scientific articles must comply with the Vancouver style (International Committee of Medical Journal Editors 2000).

PUBLICATION PRINCIPLES

The Journal is published in electronic form and includes four issues per year. Each issue can be accessed free of charge three months after the date of publication. Before that, the journal can be accessed by way of usernames and passwords of the members of the related associations, or an author password issued by the editor.
