OPEN ACCESS (IN GENERAL)

- Are you familiar with open access (the phenomenon in general)?
- What are your thoughts about open access?
- Have you ever perceived a usefulness regarding other articles being open access? For instance, had access to an article that Hanken did not have the rights to.
- Do you have anything against the idea of your articles being available as open access?
- Have you done anything to further your articles open access availability?
 - If yes: what have you done? And why have you done it?
 - If no: is there a specific reason why not?

OPEN ACCESS IN JOURNALS

- Do you know if there are open access journals within your own discipline?
 - If yes, have you ever submitted any articles to them?
 - If no, is there a specific reason why not?
- Many open access journals charge an author fee for publishing. The same is true of non-open access articles that allow articles to be published as open access through an extra payment.
 - What is your view on such practices within your research area?
 - Is it something you would be interested in?
 - If yes, what criteria would need to be met? For instance receive funding for it from elsewhere?

OPEN ACCESS ELSEWHERE (i.e. not in journals)

- Are you familiar with the concept of publisher copyright agreements, and what possible restrictions there are to your rights to make articles available outside of the published version?

SUBJECT REPOSITORIES

- Are you familiar with subject repositories (e.g. Social Science Research Network [SSRN], Repec)
 - Have you uploaded any of your articles to a subject repository?
 - How many of your articles, percentage-wise?
 - Do you think such repositories are useful?
 - Why / why not useful?

INSTITUTIONAL REPOSITORIES

- Are you familiar with D-hanken or Pure?
- What do you think about the usefulness of Hanken's repository? (D-Hanken/Pure)
- Have you put up your articles on D-Hanken / Pure?
 - If not, why?
- Would you consider it valuable if Hanken's repository were to provide usage metrics (downloads, tweets, social bookmarking, etc.) for your articles that are made available on the repository?

ACADEMIC SOCIAL NETWORKS

- Have you heard about ResearchGate, Academia.edu, and similar academic social networks?
 - What is your relationship to them - are you active as provider or user?
 - Do you have any further views or opinions regarding their usefulness (or lack thereof?)

PERSONAL WEBSITE

Do you have a personal website?

- Have you put up open access versions of your articles on your personal website?
- If not, have you considered it? Do you have anything against the idea?
