Vagn Mejdahl, head of the Nordic Luminescence Laboratory, died on August 21 1997. Among his many activities he was a leading figure on the steering committee behind the series of Nordic Archaeometry meetings. He was responsible for organising both meetings in Denmark – Elsinor in 1981 and Esbjerg in 1993 – and attended all seven meetings, including the last one in Savonlinna. His characteristically careful and friendly manner was an asset to the discussions following the lectures, all of which he attended despite his ill health. Undergirding his work was a deep interest and encouragement in building contacts between archaeologists and natural scientists.
