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COMPUTER PROGRAMS

- SWATWOL, a morphological analyser of Swahili, with ca. 45,000 lexical entries and 288 sublexicons.
- SWACGP, a Constraint Grammar parser with a rule system for disambiguating morphologically analysed Swahili text, with ca. 1200 disambiguation rules.
- Orthografix II for Kiswahili, a commercial spelling checker, available for versions of MS Word (Lingsoft Inc.).
- SWAHYP, a commercial hyphenator for Swahili (Lingsoft Inc.).
- SWATAG, a Swahili tagger, which inserts part-of-speech tags and surface syntactic tags on running text.
- SWALEM, a morphological analyser of Swahili, which finds base forms of words in running text.
- SWATOKEN, a pre-processing program, which identifies words, diacritics and punctuation marks in running text.
- SALAMA (Swahili Language Manager), a comprehensive working environment for manipulating Swahili text..
- SWALEX, a computer system that converts running corpus text into a format that is optimal for producing a conventional printed bilingual (Swahili-English) dictionary. Available also domain-specific versions, with a capability to handle multi-word concepts.
- SWAVOC, a computer system that produces a vocabulary (Swahili-English) of a running Swahili text, with a user-defined degree of linguistic information. The level of the vocabulary can be chosen on the basis of general lexical frequency. E.g. 1,000 most common words can be cut off. Suitable for language learners of various levels.
- CONJOIN-KWANYAMA, a computer system that maps between disjoining and conjoining writing systems of Kwanyama language, implemented mostly with Beta.
- CONJOIN-SOTHO, a computer system that maps between disjoining and conjoining writing systems of Northern Sotho language, implemented mostly with Perl.
