The first issue of Finnish Journal of Tribology in 2017 is actually a double issue, due to the fruitful 17th Nordic Symposium on Tribology, NORDTRIB2016, that was held last summer in Aulanko, Hämeenlinna. The symposium was hosted by the Finnish Society for Tribology and VTT Technical Research Centre of Finland Ltd. It was the largest NORDTRIB meeting ever with more than 200 participants from 28 countries. The success of the conference reflects the importance of the discipline but also that Finland is an attractive venue for international meetings.

In 2017, the tribologists in Finland have a good reason to celebrate: The Finnish Society for Tribology was founded in 1977 to support the research, technical development and education of tribology in Finland and now reaches the cornerstone of 40 years.
